**A RESOLUTION ON A RENEWAL TAX LEVY EXCEEDING THE TEN (10 MILL) LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF PERMANENT, PART-TIME, OR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS OR FIREFIGHTING COMPANIES, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF THE FIREFIGHTER EMPLOYERS' CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 742.34 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, OR THE PROVISION OF AMBULANCE, PARAMEDIC, OR OTHER EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES OPERATED BY A FIRE DEPARTMENT OR FIREFIGHTING COMPANY (O.R.C. 5705.19(I)), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members concurring as follows:

**Section 1:** The amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation are insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village of Boston Heights, and it is necessary to levy a tax exceeding that limitation for purposes of providing for the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under Section 742.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company as provided by Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(I).

**Section 2:** The purpose of the proposed tax levy is to pay permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under Section 742.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company as provided by Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(I).

**Section 3:** The proposed levy is a renewal for 0.75 ad valorem property tax outside of the ten mill limitation. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5705.03 on January 22, 2018, the County Fiscal Officer certified to the Village of Boston Heights that the tax revenue to be produced by the stated millage is calculated to be \$61,761, calculated at a tax of .75 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to Seventy-Five Cents (\$0.75 for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation).

**Section 4:** The territory covered by the proposed levy is only that within the corporate limits of the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio. Boston Heights does not have territory outside said county.

**Section 5:** The levy shall be placed on the tax list, i.e. be levied, beginning in 2018 for the first collection in 2019, if the electors voting on it approve the levy as provided by law.

**Section 6:** The levy shall be levied and remain in effect for three years, i.e.: 2018, 2019 and 2020. The levy shall be collected during 2019, 2020 and 2021.

**Section 7:** The levy shall be submitted to voted upon by the electors within the Village of Boston Heights, Summit County, Ohio at the primary election to be held on May 8, 2018. A majority shall be needed for passage.

**Section 8:** The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Boston Heights shall certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of the County of Summit no later than February 1, 2018 in order to meet the filing deadline.

**Section 9:** All prior resolutions on this exact subject and to this end are hereby repealed and rescinded.


**Section 10:** That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 11:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the community and for the timely submission of this directive to the County Board of Elections, and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
