A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO TREASURER JOSH MANDEL’S OHIO CHECKBOOK WEBSITE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the mission of the Ohio Treasury is to protect, manage, and invest state money with integrity and high ethical standards while providing innovative financial services and educational resources to all Ohioans; and,

WHEREAS, likewise, the mission of the Village of Boston Heights is to protect, manage, and invest the Village’s money with integrity and high ethical standards while providing innovative financial services and educational resources to its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, County of Summit, State of Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to work with the Ohio Treasurer’s Office to access, submit and share the Village’s expenditure information with the State Treasurer’s Office for posting on a transparency website.

Section 2: That the expenditure information has been produced and processed from sources believed to be reliable and is being provided voluntarily.


Section 3: That the expenditure information submitted by the Village will be displayed in its entirety on a transparency website and that no additions, deletions, or edits of any kind will be made to the expenditure information by the Ohio Treasurer’s office or other parties.

Section 4: That the expenditure information submitted by the Village to the Ohio Treasurer’s Office is not considered private, confidential, or protected under state or federal law and is appropriate for public viewing on a transparency website.

Section 5: That due to the Village’s limited resources, the Village’s expenditure information shall be submitted at least once a year and otherwise as often as practicable in the view of the Mayor and Fiscal Officer.

Section 6: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
