2017-2018 Capital Projects

- Repaving of Wooded View roadways, Spring 2017.
- Culvert replacement for Olde Eight Road in later 2017.
- Olde Eight Road resurfacing [Phase II, from Rt. 303 to Boston Mills Rd.] follows culvert installation in the Fall and [Phase I, from Boston Mills to Northfield Township Line], scheduled for Spring 2018.
- Scheduled completion of Olde Eight Rd. and Wolcott, Sholle, Meghan's Lane, Grandview, Richard, Beverly and W. Boston Mills is set for later 2018.
- Preliminary plans for the Boston Heights to Hudson Trail to be completed in order to seek funding from ODNR and AMATS for future trail construction.

Boston Heights Police

The Village of Boston Height Police Department presently is composed of a Chief, a Sergeant, 2 full time officers and 10 part time officers that include a part time lieutenant and part time sergeant. They provide 24/7 coverage for our community with two officers on all shifts.

Boston Heights Police provide house checks for vacationing residents and place seniors in the village on a checklist to receive regular checks or phone calls if a senior agrees to do so..

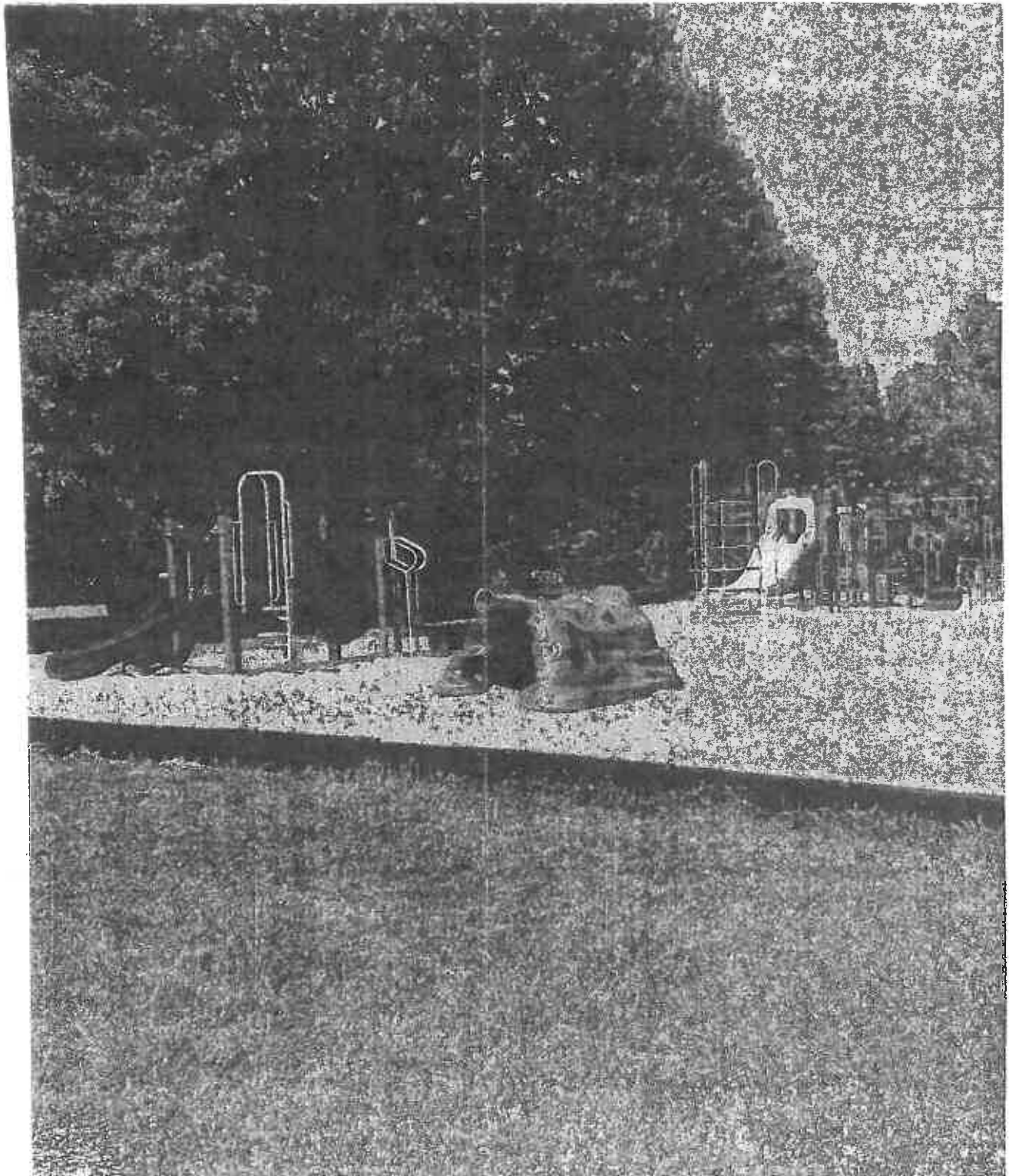

Mayor's Report:

The Village of Boston Heights

Our Zoning Department has been working with Village property owners making them aware of village ordinances regarding lawn mowing, yard and building maintenance, and trash accumulation on their properties. The zoning official initially asks for voluntary compliance and makes suggestions on possible ways of becoming compliant. After a specified period of time further action will be taken for non-compliance. Please be considerate of your neighbors.

The Village, ODOT and Ohio Turnpike Commission have been reviewing traffic backups on Rt. 8 northbound in the afternoon timeframe. Timing of gates open and widening the off ramp from the eastbound OTC mainline have resolved some issues.

Dominion Energy has lowered gas lines along Olde Eight Road in preparation for eight culvert replacements beneath the entire length of Olde Eight Road. Resurfacing of Olde Eight Road will follow in years 2017 and 2018.
